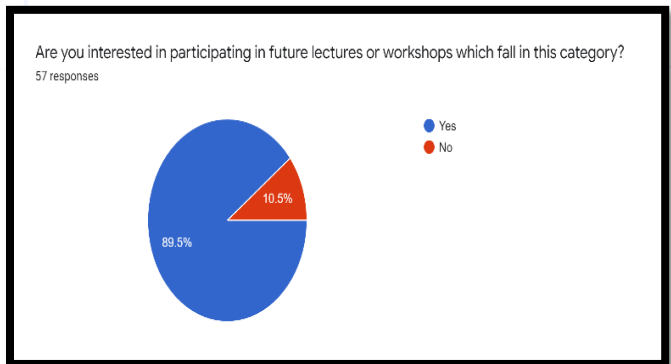
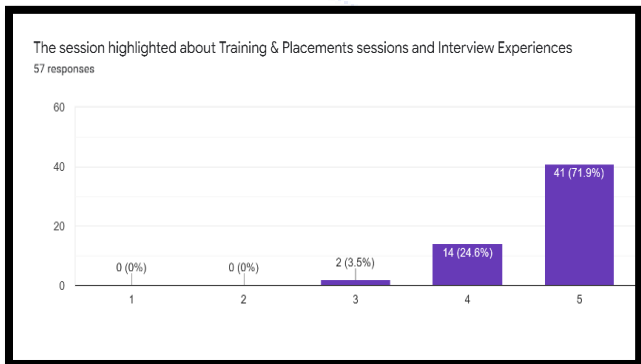
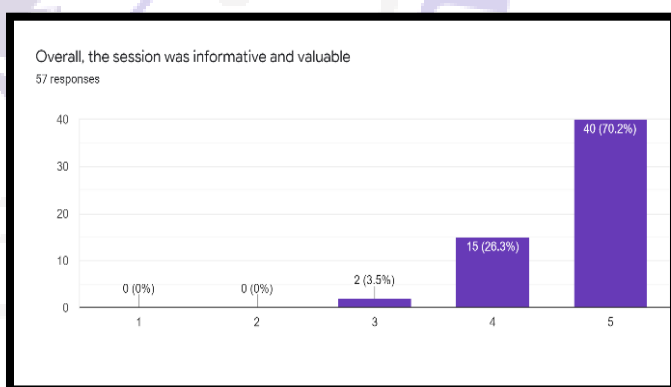
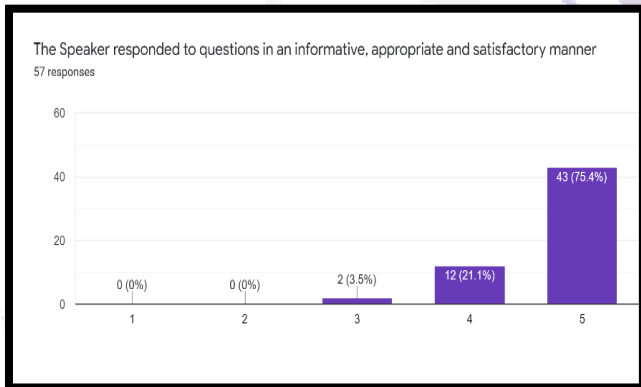
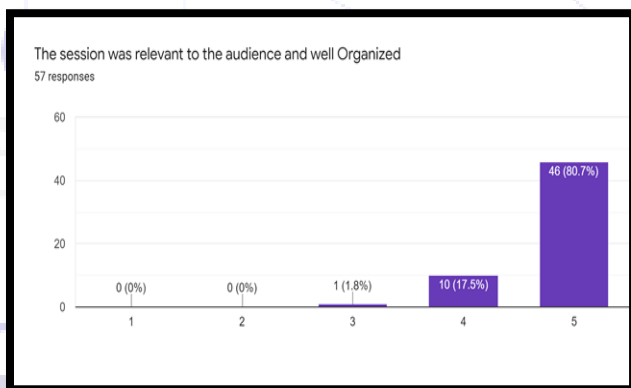
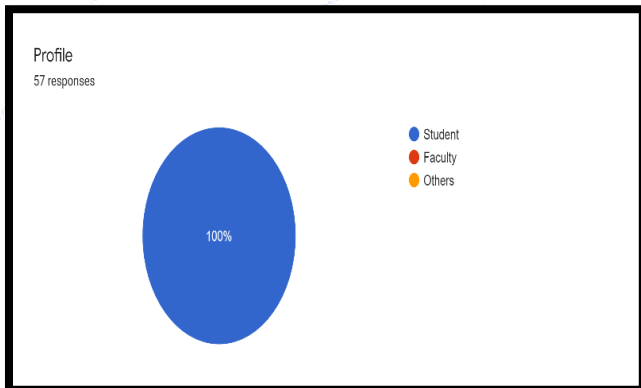
- On 4th June 2021, IEEE-DBIT-WIE Student Chapter organized a session on “Insights into Life at DBIT”

- The session was followed by a Q&A round with the participants wherein the speaker answered the queries such related to aptitude preparation sources, strategy to bag the highest package, significance of placement cell related activities, various college department chapters, time management, etc.

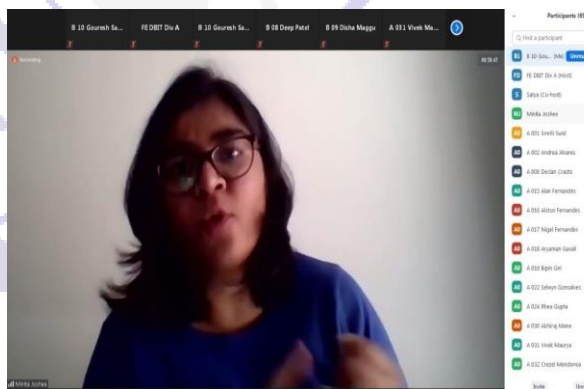
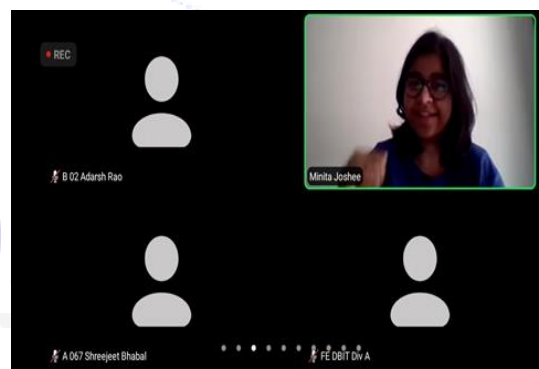
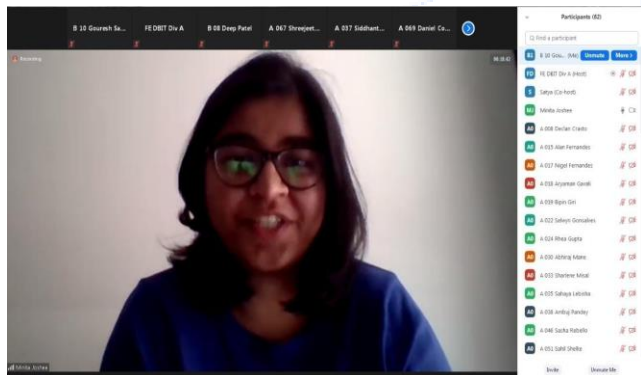


Summary of Webinar Analysis:
