#### **Description:**

Prof. Gaurav Sharma began the session by explaining the need for writing technical papers which is a critical step towards scientific progress. Some of the key points discussed were that, of the many steps you will take to successfully publish your work, none is more important than following the highest ethical standards while you conduct and write about your research. You must understand what is and is not acceptable in writing your article. Cutting corners could negatively impact your reputation.

Prof. Sharma gave a brief introduction about IEEE and its background. Detailed discussion regarding the following sections were done:

1. Ethics in scientific publishing
2. Selection of appropriate format
3. Selecting where to submit
4. Developing your manuscript
5. Improving and revising
6. Submissions
7. Peer review

Once you have revised your article, it must be returned to the editorial office. In the near future it will appear on IEEE Xplore alongside the most significant articles published in your area of research. There are a few final steps you will take, however, before your article can be published in print and online.
